We have had a fun week in school this week with all the children taking part in activities to celebrate the 'European Day of Language' which was on Monday. It has given us lots of opportunities to explore different languages, learn about other European countries and celebrate the range of languages that many of our school families speak.

Here are some of the things the children have been learning about!

- Reception have been answering the register every day in different languages.
- Year 1 sang the song 'Hello to all the Children of the World' and discussed the different ways children greet each other.
- Year 2 have learned familiar songs in different languages such as 'Heads, Shoulders, Knees and Toes' in French..
- Year 3 learned how to say hello in different languages and have learned a range of Spanish phrases.
- Year 4 completed a matching flag quiz to European countries using atlases as well as learning to greet others in 15 different languages.
