- We think it is important for you to know where to get help if you are worried or unhappy about something

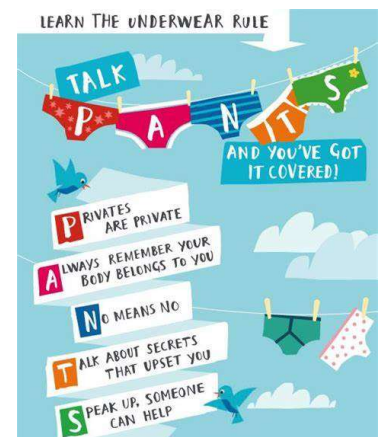
If you need to talk to an adult, we will listen:

- You can tell a friend and go with your friend to tell an adult

Don't keep it a secret if someone is:

- Bullying you
- Saying funny things to you that you don't like or something that upsets you
- Touching you
- Trying to give you something you shouldn't have such as cigarettes, alcohol or drugs or give you presents to make you do something you don't want to do
- Hitting you or hurting you in some way
- Taking your things
- Sending unkind messages on the internet or to your phone
- Asking you to send pictures of yourself that you don't want to
